FEEES

We can only accept cash or checks at this time due to internet limitations.

ENTRY FEES: (Unless, otherwise noted in class descriptions)

Pre-entry: \$15 per class

Entries received as pre-entry may add additional classes during show for \$15 per class.

Post-Entry: \$20 per class.

SCRATCH FEE: One \$15 fee. The balance of the scratched entry fees will be refunded less the \$15 Scratch fee.

Scratch/Add substitutions will not be charged.

NON-SHOWING HORSES: \$50

CAMPER FEE: \$25

EMT FEE: \$5 per rider per day

OFFICE FEE: \$5 per entry per day

STABLING FEES (includes night watch)

Permanent stabling with gates/doors. Stabling fees are non-refundable. Owners/Trainers are responsible for damages to stabling and structures.

Tack Stalls **\$110**

Bedding **\$8** per bag

Stall reservations close Sept 15th. Please include shavings orders. Stalls will not be held and shavings will not be ordered without payment in advance and checks may be deposited as received.

***SCHOOLING: The show rings will be available for schooling from 1 PM to 7:30 PM Friday September 24, before and after the show each day, and during scheduled breaks.**

***REFUNDS**

Once a class has started, horses not shown in classes in which they have entered, forfeit their entry fees, except if a horse is injured or becomes ill prior to the class.

***PARKING & CAMPING**

Limited camper spaces are available. Please order in advance and park in designated areas.

***Dogs must be on leashes at all times**

***Management** reserves the right to combine, divide, or cancel classes as entries warrant and post an order of go. Management reserves the right to refuse an entry.

*Riders must wear approved **Helmets** at all times while mounted.

***Stallions** may not be shown or handled by anyone under the age of 18.

***Holding of Rings due to conflicts:** Riders and Trainers should notify the paddock masters about potential conflicts.

***Hunter Courses** will simulate fences in the hunting field such as brush, wall, in-and-out, oxer, post and rail, gate, aiken, and panels. The courtesy circle may be restricted as indicated by a line on posted course diagrams.

***Awards**

All classes, except Schooling Hunter Over Fences will receive ribbons awarded to 6th place unless class description denotes otherwise. A Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded to the following hunter divisions each day.

PLEASE NOTE: Up & Over members will only receive double points towards year end awards no matter how many entries are in a class.

HUNTER CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

All Hunter Classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless stated otherwise in the class descriptions.

Blue/Red Schooling Hunter Over Fences

Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Schooling rounds may be ridden before any division at the same fence height. Horses and ponies will be judged and given a numerical score. Competitor's score is announced after the course is jumped. Scores of 77-100 will earn a blue ribbon. Scores of 70-76 will earn a red ribbon, Scores of 69 and below do not receive a ribbon. Ribbons may be picked up upon exiting the ring.

Champion & Reserve Champion awarded each day to the following divisions.

Miscellaneous Pleasure

Pts: U&O

This division includes the following three classes. Competitors may **not** cross enter into Extremely Green Rider or Extremely Green Hunter, Walk/ Trot/Canter, or Walk/ Trot Rider or Walk /Trot Hunter classes. Martingales are prohibited.

Open Hunter Under Saddle: Open to horses and ponies to be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Entries will be judged performance, manners and way of going,

Hunter Pleasure: Open to horses and ponies, to be ridden on a reasonably loose rein without loss of contact and shown at the walk, trot and canter and to stand quietly and may be asked to back. Entries judged on manners, performance and suitability for pleasure.

Hunter Hack: Open to horses and ponies to be shown at walk, trot, and canter. Competitors will also be required to jump two fences at 2'0" and may be asked to Hand Gallop.

Open to all horses and ponies. Exhibitors may only show at one fence height in this division. Please indicate fence height on entry blank.

Baby Green/MHJA Very Green Hunter

(Fences 2'0"-2'3") Pts: U&O, MHJA, WPaPHA

Open to horses or ponies with very limited show experience not exceeding 2'6". Manners and suitability are emphasized. Trotting is permitted. Horses may also enter Extremely Green Hunter or Low Hunter (2'6") but not both. Horses may enter divisions with amateur or junior classification not exceeding 2'6".

Open to junior and amateur riders who have not competed higher than 2'6". Manners and suitability are emphasized. Trotting is permitted. Riders may also enter Extremely Green Rider or Intermediate Rider, but not both.

Points received in all classes go with the rider. If a rider shows more than one horse/pony in this division at the same show, only the highest scoring mounts' points will be awarded to that rider for that show.

NEW THIS YEAR: A perpetual trophy in memory of Heather and Barbara Gibson will be awarded to the rider who accumulates the most total points in this division from both the June & September U&O shows.

Open to amateur riders. Riders may not cross enter into divisions with fence heights greater than 2'6". Riders are not eligible for this division if they have competed in over fences classes with fence heights greater than 2'6" in the last THREE years. Rider may enter in Extremely Green Rider or Low Adult Hunter, but not both. . Points received in all classes go with the rider. If a rider shows more than one horse/pony in this division at the same show, only the highest scoring mounts' points will be awarded to that rider for that show.

This division is for horses and ponies of any age that are not yet capable of cantering in competition. Horse or pony is no longer eligible once it has competed at any time in a canter class. Slight mistakes will not be heavily penalized.

Riders are ineligible once they have competed at any time in a regular Walk/Trot/Canter class or competed in classes with fence heights greater than 18". Slight mistakes will not be penalized. Points received in all classes go with the rider. If a rider shows more than one horse/pony in this division at the same show, only the highest scoring mounts' points will be awarded to that rider for that show.

Riders are no longer eligible once they have competed in a canter class or in an over fences class. Riders may not cross enter into any other classes, except Hunter in Hand classes and WT Ground poles.

Riders may not cross enter into any other classes, except Hunter in Hand classes and Walk Trot Rider Not to Jump.

time. Courses may be trotted. Slight mistakes will not be heavily penalized. Points received in all classes go with the rider. If a rider shows more than one

horse/pony in this division at the same show, only the highest scoring mounts' points will be awarded to that rider for that show.

Open to horses or ponies of any age just learning to canter, who have never shown in over fences classes exceeding 2'3". **No more than SIX entries to canter at one time.** Horses in this division may cross enter into Baby Green Hunter Classes, but not Miscellaneous Hack Classes.

Slight mistakes will not be heavily penalized.

Open to riders just learning to canter and who have never jumped in classes exceeding 2'3". **No more than SIX entries to canter at one time.** Course may be trotted. Slight mistakes will not be heavily penalized. Competitors in this division may cross enter into Beginner Rider or Adult Rider, but are not eligible for Miscellaneous Hack Classes. Points received in all classes go with the rider. If a rider shows more than one horse/pony in this division at the same show, only the highest scoring mounts' points will be awarded to that rider for that show.

INDIVIDUAL/SPECIAL CLASSES

Open Hunter In Hand Pts: U&O

Open to all horses and ponies. Stallions may not be shown by junior exhibitors. Entries judged on conformation, way of moving, quality, substance, soundness, manners, and suitability as a hunter or to become a hunter. Minor blemishes not the fault of poor conformation not to be heavily penalized. Entries are to be moved on the line at the walk and trot. To be shown in appropriate bridle (except weanlings). Unsound entries must be eliminated.
