#### **FEEES**

**Due to poor internet connectivity credit card payments cannot be processed at this time.**

**ENTRY FEES:** (Unless, otherwise noted in class descriptions)

**Pre-entry: \$15** per class

Entries received as pre-entry may add additional classes during show for \$15 or the original entry fee per class.

**Post-Entry: \$20** per class.

**SCRATCH FEE:** One \$15 fee. The balance of the scratched entry fees will be refunded less the \$15 Scratch fee.

Scratch/Add substitutions will not be charged.

**NSF Fee: \$25.** Individuals with an outstanding balance owed the show will be sent a letter giving them 30 days to settle their account. If the account is not settled all points accumulated by that individual and their horses or ponies will not be counted towards Up & Over year end awards. The other affiliated organizations will also be notified.

**NON-SHOWING HORSES: \$50**

**CAMPER FEE: \$25**

**STABLING FEES: (includes night watch)**

Permanent stabling with gates/doors. Stabling fees are non-refundable. Owners/Trainers are responsible for damages to stabling and structures.

**Stall reservations close June 13th. Please include shavings orders. Stalls will not be held without payment and checks may be deposited as received. Stalls available Friday June 24th at noon.**

**UNJUDGED TICKETED WARM-UP: \$10 per ticket.** Open all day preceding each hunter division in both rings. Tickets may be purchased in the office or at the in gate and must be presented at the in gate before entering the ring.

**\*SCHOOLING: The show rings will be available for schooling from 1 PM to 7:30 PM Friday June 24, before and after the show each day, and during 15-minute scheduled breaks. The Tentative breaks may be shortened or eliminated at the Show Manager's discretion.**

**\*REFUNDS**

Once a class has started, horses not shown in classes in which they have entered, forfeit their entry fees, except if a horse is injured or becomes ill prior to the class.

**\*PARKING & CAMPING:**

Limited camper spaces are available for \$25. Please park in designated areas

**\*Dogs must be on leashes at all times**

**\*Management** reserves the right to combine, divide, or cancel classes as entries warrant and post an order of go. Management reserves the right to refuse an entry.

\*Riders must wear approved **Helmets** at all times while mounted.

\***Stallions** may not be shown or handled by anyone under the age of 18.

\***Holding of Rings due to conflicts:** Riders and Trainers should notify the paddock masters about potential conflicts.

\***Hunter Courses** will simulate fences in the hunting field such as brush, wall, in-and-out, oxer, post and rail, gate, aiken, and panels. The courtesy circle may be restricted as indicated by a line on posted course diagrams.

\* **Exhibitors should always check class and or division specifications to ensure compliance with each organization's requirements.**

**\*Awards**

All classes, except Ticketed Warm-up will receive ribbons awarded to 6th place unless class description denotes otherwise. A Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded to the following divisions each day.

**PLEASE NOTE: Up & Over members will only receive double points towards year end awards no matter how many entries are in a class.**

## HUNTER CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

---

**All Hunter Classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless stated otherwise in the class descriptions.**

### Miscellaneous Pleasure

Pts: U&O

This division includes the following three classes. Competitors may **not** cross enter into Extremely Green Rider or Extremely Green Hunter, Walk/ Trot/Canter, or Walk/ Trot Rider or Walk /Trot Hunter classes. Martingales are prohibited.

**Open Hunter Under Saddle:** Open to horses and ponies to be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Entries will be judged performance, manners and way of going,

**Hunter Pleasure:** Open to horses and ponies, to be ridden on a reasonably loose rein without loss of contact and shown at the walk, trot and canter and to stand quietly and may be asked to back. Entries judged on manners, performance and suitability for pleasure.

**Hunter Hack:** Open to horses and ponies to be shown at walk, trot, and canter. Competitors will also be required to jump two fences at 2'0" and may be asked to Hand Gallop.

### Low Hunter

### Baby Green Hunter

(Fences 2'0"-2'3") Pts: U&O, MHJA Very Green, WPaPHA

Open to **horses or ponies** with very limited show experience not exceeding 2'6". Manners and suitability are emphasized. Trotting is permitted. Horses may also enter Extremely Green Hunter or Low Hunter (2'6") but not both. Horses may enter divisions with amateur or junior classification not exceeding 2'6".

Points received in all classes go with the rider. If a rider shows more than one horse/pony in this division at the same show, only the highest scoring mounts' points will be awarded to that rider for that show.

### Adult Rider

(Fences 2'0"-2'3") Pts: U&O, MHJA Low Adult

**A perpetual trophy in memory of Heather and Barbara Gibson will be awarded in September to the Adult Rider who accumulates the most total points showing in this division both days at the June & September U&O Double Point Shows.**

Open to **amateur riders**. Riders may not cross enter into divisions with fence heights greater than 2'6". Riders are not eligible for this division if they have competed in over fences classes with fence heights greater than 2'6" in the last THREE years. Rider may enter in Extremely Green Rider or Low Adult Hunter, but not both. Points received in all classes go with the rider. If a rider shows more than one horse/pony in this division at the same show, only the highest scoring mounts' points will be awarded to that rider for that show.

If a rider shows more than one horse/pony in this division at the same show, only the highest scoring mounts' points will be awarded to that rider for that show.

Slight mistakes will not be heavily penalized. Competitors in this division may cross enter into Beginner Rider or Adult Rider, but are not eligible for Miscellaneous Hack Classes. Points received in all classes go with the rider. If a rider shows more than one horse/pony in this division at the same show, only the highest scoring mounts' points will be awarded to that rider for that show.

Minor blemishes not the fault of poor conformation not to be heavily penalized. Entries are to be moved on the line at the walk and trot. To be shown in appropriate bridle (except weanlings). Unsound entries must be eliminated.

## JUMPERS

---

**Up & Over members should track their own points for year-end awards on an Up & Over Jumper Point Form**

### Jumper Class Descriptions

**Time Allowed (TA)** is calculated by taking the length of the course, measured in meters (m) divided by the speed, measured in meters per minute (mpm). For example, the length of the course is 525m and the speed is 350mpm.

Take  $525 / 350 = 1.5$ . Converting this to minutes would = 1 minute and 30 seconds.

(0.25 = 15 secs, 0.5 = 30 secs, 0.75 = 45 secs., 1.0 = 60 secs.)

**Optimum Time (OT)** is 4 seconds less than the Time Allowed.

**Time Limit (TL)** is double the Time Allowed. The course must be completed within the Time Limit or the rider will be eliminated.

**Jump Off (JO)** If the rider has a clean first round and the class has a JO, the rider stays in the ring and jumps the Jump Off course.

**Table IV sec.1**

(Lowest penalties and closest to first round Optimum Time wins. NO JO)

The first round is decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course (i.e. knockdown, refusal etc.) and any penalties for exceeding the TA. In case of equality of faults, ties will be broken on the following basis; an OT will be posted on the course plan; the horse with the closest to this OT (over or under) will prevail in a tie.

**Table II, sec. 1** This is a speed round. Fastest time with least faults wins.

**Table II, sec. 2(b)**

(1<sup>st</sup> round clean-stay in for JO. Lowest penalties & fastest JO time wins.)

All clean first rounds will proceed directly to JO after audible signal. Placings are determined by fastest, lowest fault JO rounds. Riders leaving the ring after the first round will be considered as retiring from the JO. Riders may dismount after a clean first round, if necessary and with assistance to adjust tack/ equipment. If there are no clean first rounds, and a tie exists for first place due to equality of faults, there will be one JO in which time will decide the placings.
